The Massachusetts Superior Court is now accepting applications for judicial law clerk positions for the 2007-2008 term. Enclosed is a prospectus which describes the position and the application procedure. I would appreciate it if you would post this prospectus in a place visible to members of your organization.

The Superior Court employs approximately fifty-four law clerks to serve its eighty-two judges. The clerkship commences September 1, 2007 and entails a one-year commitment to the court. Law clerks assist the judges in civil and criminal trials and prepare memoranda and draft decisions on both criminal and civil matters.
